5 CONSTRUCTION HEADLINES

□ Average U.S. Contractor has 8.9 Months Worth of Work in the Pipeline After declining to a seven-month low in March, backlog rebounded in April due to strength in the infrastructure category. Regionally, backlog increased in the Northeast and West but fell in the South and middle states. ABC's Construction Confidence Index reading for sales and staffing moved higher in April, while the readings for profit margins inched

lower. All three readings remain above the threshold of 50, indicating expectation of growth over the next six month. (Building Design + Construction)

□ Details on Minnesota \$2.6 Billion Bonding, Infrastructure Package Came Late. Here They Are.

Minnesota lawmakers on May 22nd passed a \$2.58 billion package of infrastructure projects, snapping a nearly three-year period without what's known as a "bonding" bill. The package was made up of a \$1.5 billion bonding bill and a \$1.1 billion cash bill. Together, they contain: (1) More than \$317 million to upgrades to college buildings in the University of Minnesota and Minnesota State systems, (2) \$247 million for the Department of Natural Resources to use on things like parks, trails, boat docks and building upgrades, (3) About \$9 million for security upgrades at the State Capitol, (4) Upgrades at military readiness centers and a host of police and fire stations, (5) \$77.7 million to fund an overhaul of a veterans home in Hastings, (6) \$402 million for the Minnesota Department of Transportation, mainly for use on road and bridge improvements, (7) More than \$501 million for water infrastructure projects, (8) More than \$443 million for economic development initiatives, much of which is earmarked for capital investment helping nonprofits in the Twin Cities metro aimed at helping people of color, and (9) Money for ski hills, ice rinks, theaters, playgrounds, museums, sports centers, wellness centers and more. ☐ Minnesota Near Top of 'Best States' Ranking; We're No. 1 in Infrastructure

Minnesotans might not believe it, but our state reportedly has the best infrastructure in the country, according to a new report by the U.S. News & World Report in its 2023 Best States ranking, U.S. News considers 70 metrics and tens of thousands of data points across three years, with categories covering health care, education, economy, infrastructure, opportunity, fiscal stability, crime and corrections and natural environment. The infrastructure category doesn't just review the quality of roads and bridges, but also the use of renewable energy and access to high-speed internet. (Minneapolis / St. Paul Business Journal)

☐ Top 4 Data Types to Collect on the Construction Jobsite

How exactly does a business use data to increase productivity in their operations? The first step in leveraging data-driven insights is collecting information from connected machines and tools on the jobsite. This can range from large excavators and material handling equipment to cordless hand tools and wearables. There are many types of data available on construction sites, capable of providing the feedback and information you need to minimize risk when making operational decisions. (For Construction Pros)

☐ How NASA Plans to Melt the Moon --- and Build on Mars

In June a four-person crew will enter a hangar at NASA's Johnson Space Center in Houston, Texas, and spend one year inside a 3D printed building. Made of a slurry that --before it dried --- looked like neatly laid lines of soft-serve ice cream. Mars Dune Alpha has crew quarters, shared living space, and dedicated areas for administering medical care and growing food. The 1,700-square-foot space, which is the color of Martian soil, was designed by architecture firm BIG - Bjarke Ingels Group and 3D printed by Icon Technology. Experiments inside the structure will focus on the physical and behavioral health challenges people will encounter during long-term residencies in space. But it's also the first structure built for a NASA mission by the Moon to Mars Planetary Autonomous Construction Technology (MPACT) team, which is preparing now for the first construction projects on a planetary body beyond Earth. (Wired)
